Dear customer!

Congratulations on choosing a Villeroy & Boch product! The utmost care in the selection of materials and stringent quality controls form the grounds for our production standards. Our bathroom furniture is suitable for normal bathroom conditions.

General Instructions

- **Electrical installation**

Electrical components such as mirror cabinets, illuminated mirrors, lighting and plug sockets must be fitted by a qualified electrician and should only be installed in area 3 as defined in VDE 0100 Part 701. Work on electrical installations may be carried out only by an approved electrician in accordance with local regulations.

- **Real wood / real wood veneer**

Wood is a natural product. Variations in colour, texture, grain etc., small branches, twigs and knots are not quality defects but proof of the naturalness of the material. Complaints about such variations cannot be accepted.

- **Furniture surfaces**

Furniture surfaces should not be left wet or damp for long periods and should therefore be wiped dry with a cloth as soon as possible. No claims based on swelling of the material due to the effects of water shall be accepted. All surfaces demonstrate limited UV resistance. Colour changes may occur if products are exposed to continuous UV radiation. Traces of use on lacquered furniture surfaces are no reason for complaints. Avoid contact with abrasive, peaked and sharp objects.

- Please ensure all **chemicals** such as hair dyes, decalcifying agents, nail-varnish remover, perfume etc. are removed from surfaces without delay.

- **Connection of washbasin countertops / washbasin to wall**

Seal the joint between the wall and washbasin countertop with silicon, observing the manufacturer's instructions.

- **Damage**

Scratches and marks on varnished, powder-coated, veneered or laminated sections should be sealed as soon as possible to prevent any further damage to the surface.

- **Colour samples of furniture finishes**

Samples are non-binding and only give a rough idea of the appearance of the surfaces.

Cleaning and Care

Never use abrasive cleaners or those containing acids or solvents. Always dry thoroughly after cleaning!

- **Bathroom furniture** should be cleaned with low pressure using a soft, clean and damp cloth, warm water and mild household cleaning agent. (e.g. diluted washing-up liquid).
- Clean **mirrors** with a damp window (chamois) leather. Wipe the edges dry.
- Wipe **leather and imitation leather** with a micro fibre cloth and lukewarm water.
- **Metal surfaces** should be cleaned using a soft, damp cloth, warm water and mild household cleaning agent. (e.g. diluted washing-up liquid).
- **Electrical components** must always be switched off before cleaning. Use a dry cloth.
- **Stainless steel parts** should be cleaned with a soft, fuzz-free cloth and a non-abrasive stainless steel cleaner. Spray the cleaner on to the cloth and then wipe the parts clean.
- **Natural stone slabs** have been impregnated and should be cleaned in the same way as furniture. Please read the separate instructions with additional information on cleaning marble slabs.
- **Artificial stone countertops** can be polished using a suitable substance (e.g. car polish).
- **Flock coating** should be cleaned with a soft brush and household cleaning agent.
- **PLEASE NOTE! Effective ventilation of the bathroom is essential in order to maintain the quality and appearance of the furniture.**
